Check out these staff recommended titles for kids and teens

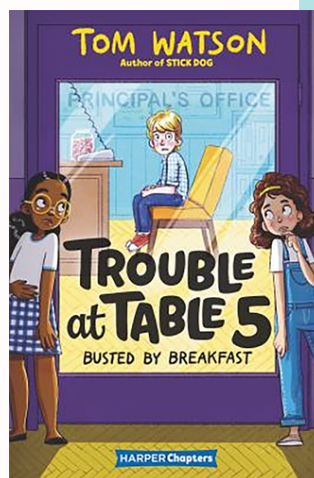
## ***We Want a Dog*** by Lo Cole

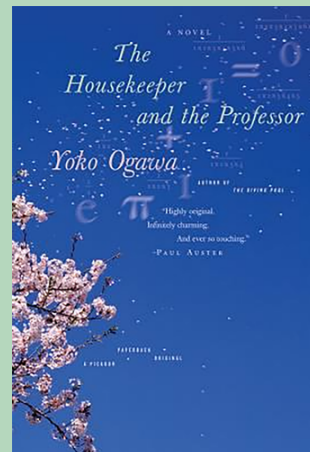
