## RFID complete and new self-check machines installed

**"Wow, it's like  
magic!"**

You may have noticed some changes at the library recently. One of the most noticeable changes is the new self-check-out machines.

These space-age looking machines check out materials by reading the RFID (radio frequency identification) tag in the item.

While the materials still have barcodes, the



machines actually read the tag instead. This means the machines can check out multiple items

at one time, which means a faster, better experience for the user.

We are excited to have these new self-check machines, and they seem pretty popular with library users: nearly 70% of library items are checked out using the self-check machines.

More changes are coming, and that is not a bad thing! Look for updates about our upcoming remodel.
