These items belong in the TRASH

Do your part and recycle RIGHT!
Do NOT put these items in your recycling.

To-go containers & produce containers

All to-go containers, salad containers, berry containers, plastic utensils, and more.



To-go cups

All to-go cups (paper, plastic, Styrofoam™) for hot & cold beverages, including lids & straws.



Plastic bags & plastic wrap

Plastic grocery bags, bread bags, plastic shipping envelopes, dry-cleaning bags, bubble wrap, and more.



Frozen food boxes

Frozen dinner boxes & trays, frozen pizza boxes, ice cream cartons, popsicle boxes, and more.



Styrofoam™ & packing peanuts

Packing peanuts, Styrofoam™ blocks, meat trays, and more.
